# Railroad Incident and Safety Course (RISC)

<u>Course Description</u>: Train-related incidents occur approximately Every 3 hours in the United States and may require first responders at the scene. These incidents often present complex and unique safety concerns for responders.

To address these issues, the Railroad Incident and Safety Course (RISC) program offers instruction on how to manage train-related incidents safely and maintain on-scene safety. This eight hour course will cover the following modules and conclude with a four hour field exercise with a locomotive and rail cars.

**MODULE 2 - On-Scene Safety & Situational Awareness** 

**MODULE 3 - Rail Resources & Initial Report Information** 

**MODULE 4 - Rail Incident Conclusion** 

<u>Recommended Participants</u>: This course is geared towards law enforcement and first responders, teaching them how to be safe on and around railroad tracks while they are investigating an incident.
